MUCC ACTIVITY – from Dick Kriner

Not everyone in the Club gets the MUCC magazine so I would like to highlight some items in our newsletter. Such as:

- NRC shoots down the one-buck rule in the UP for now. Will reconsider later.
- 2. Two new laws reduce the minimum hunting ages for big game from 14 to 12 years and small game from 12 to 10 years of age.
- 3. November ballot, Proposal 3 will reinstate dove hunting. Vote yes
- 4. MUCC/Camo Coalition action has funded the Asian Carp barriers for 2006 but funding for next year has not passed the legislature.
- 5. At the annual convention of MUCC delegates voted to delist the gray wolf in Michigan; to work with the DNR to reduce doe permits in eastern UP; not to recognize the taking of wildlife in high-fence enclosures as proposed by the World Hunting Association to have tournaments like bass fishing.

DNR HUNTER EDUCATION

Location: South Haven Rod & Gun Club 68611 8th Ave South Haven, Michigan **Dates & Times:** Sept. 18,19,20,21,22 6:00pm - 9:30pm

This is a 5 day class totaling 15+ hours. Students must attend all sessions.

Fees: No Charge - A \$5.00 donation is appreciated. All monies collected go to support Hunter Education. Instructors: Dan Hosier, Vern Hosier

The goal of the Michigan Hunter Education Safety program is to train knowledgeable, safe and responsible hunters. Further, the hunter education program will strive to inform all the citizens of the interrelationship between modern wildlife management and responsible/ethical hunting practices.

Hunting is a life long recreational activity, which can be enjoyed by all persons. The hunter education course is designed to provide the student those basic skills. which allow the novice hunter participate in the sport safely and responsibly. It is a basic course and does not purport to teach the student all there is to know about hunting in Michigan or guarantee that the person will never be injured or will never injure someone else in an accident. Persons who successfully complete the course will be better prepared to hunt in Michigan.

State law requires all first time hunters, born after January 1,1960, successfully complete a hunter education course prior to purchasing a license to hunt.

The following criteria will be used in evaluating each student for certification:

- 1) Class attendance at <u>all</u> sessions. (must attend the full 5 days unless arrangements have been made)
- 2) <u>Prompt</u> attendance at class sessions.
- 3) <u>Completion</u> of all homework assignments.
- 4) <u>Participation</u> in class activities and discussions.
- 5) Performance on standard test.
- 6) <u>Performance</u> on the firing range/field exercise
- 7) <u>Behavior</u> in class and on range/field exercise.
