Membership Cap is lifted

The membership has voted to remove the 225 member limit in the Club's By-Laws with a final vote at the February meeting. That means we are now open to as many members as we would like to accept. This action was brought about because we hit our limit of 225 members last October and were not able to accept new members until spots opened up from non-renewals.

In addition to the lifting of the cap we now have put into practice a new application and renewal process. To now join you must fill out a application and have a current member sponsor you. Once the application is submitted the individual applying will have their name read at a general membership meeting for comments. In the next month the investigating committee will do a background check and if no red flags come up the applicant will then be put up for a vote of acceptance at the next general meeting. Thereafter, they will be given a orientation, issued a membership card and allowed to get a building key.

Renewals will be treated that if your fully completed renewal form and dues are not received by February 1st of the next year you will no longer be a member and will have to apply as a new member with a possible new initiation fee and be reorientated. Late dues submittals will no longer be tolerated since they create too much work for our Membership Secretary and other volunteers.

Lots of New Ideas for Activities in the Making

This will get set up as soon as the weather breaks and we can put together all the tables.
