It seems the South Haven City Council was making some changes to an ordinance and one of our members realized that the ordinance had some wording that banned firearms from City parks.

personal protection. So a quick review of City Ordinances and an email to the Council has them reviewing the situation with their Lawyer.

From my review I found two Ordinances (58-83 and 18-34) to be violation of State Law (MCL 123.1102). In light of the

recent Civil Lawsuit against Grand Haven for the arrest of the gentleman open carrying a pistol last year, at a festival the city might want to move forward and make some changes to comply with State Law before they are in court for violating Civil Rights.
